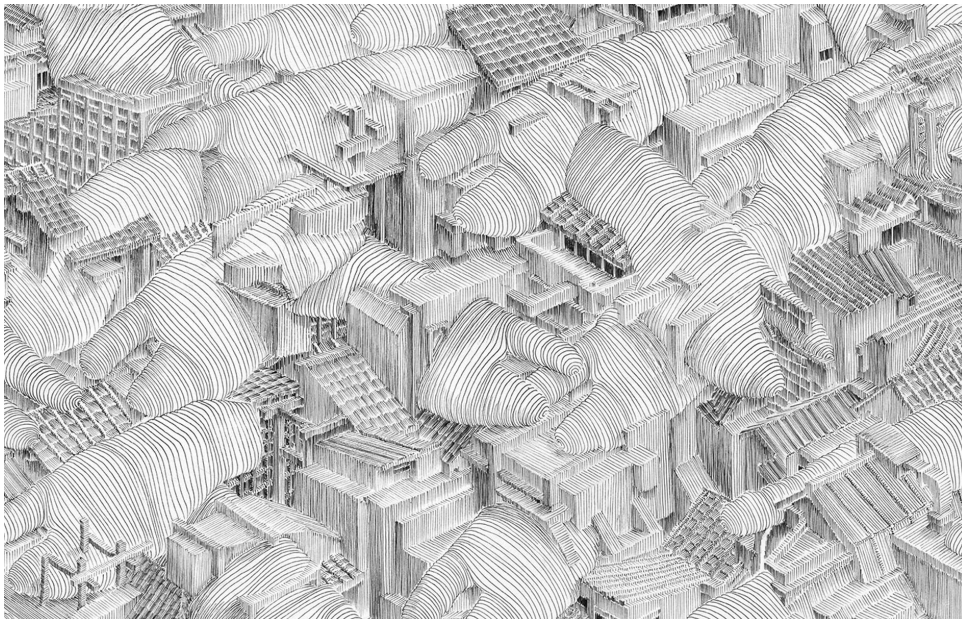


Georg Bohle – Other Spaces – EN

Georg Bohle views the built environment and pristine landscapes as cultural metaphors that provide a context for his work. Some of Bohle's drawings show graphic interpretations of textures and compositional structures from man-made agglomerations. Other works display mountain sceneries with anthropomorphic rock formations.

Within the tension between architectural and natural forms, Bohle develops a growing series of Imaginary Landscapes. Amid realistic and imaginative elements grows a repertoire of volumes, textures, objects and emblems which, combined, give his landscapes new meaning. Looking at the the ambiguity of the curious and the familiar in Bohle's drawings one may turn to Michel Foucault's notion of 'heterotopia' that he elaborated in 'Of Other Spaces' (1967). One may borrow this notion to contemplate Bohle's works for they seem to exist in a space of 'otherness': it is neither here nor there.

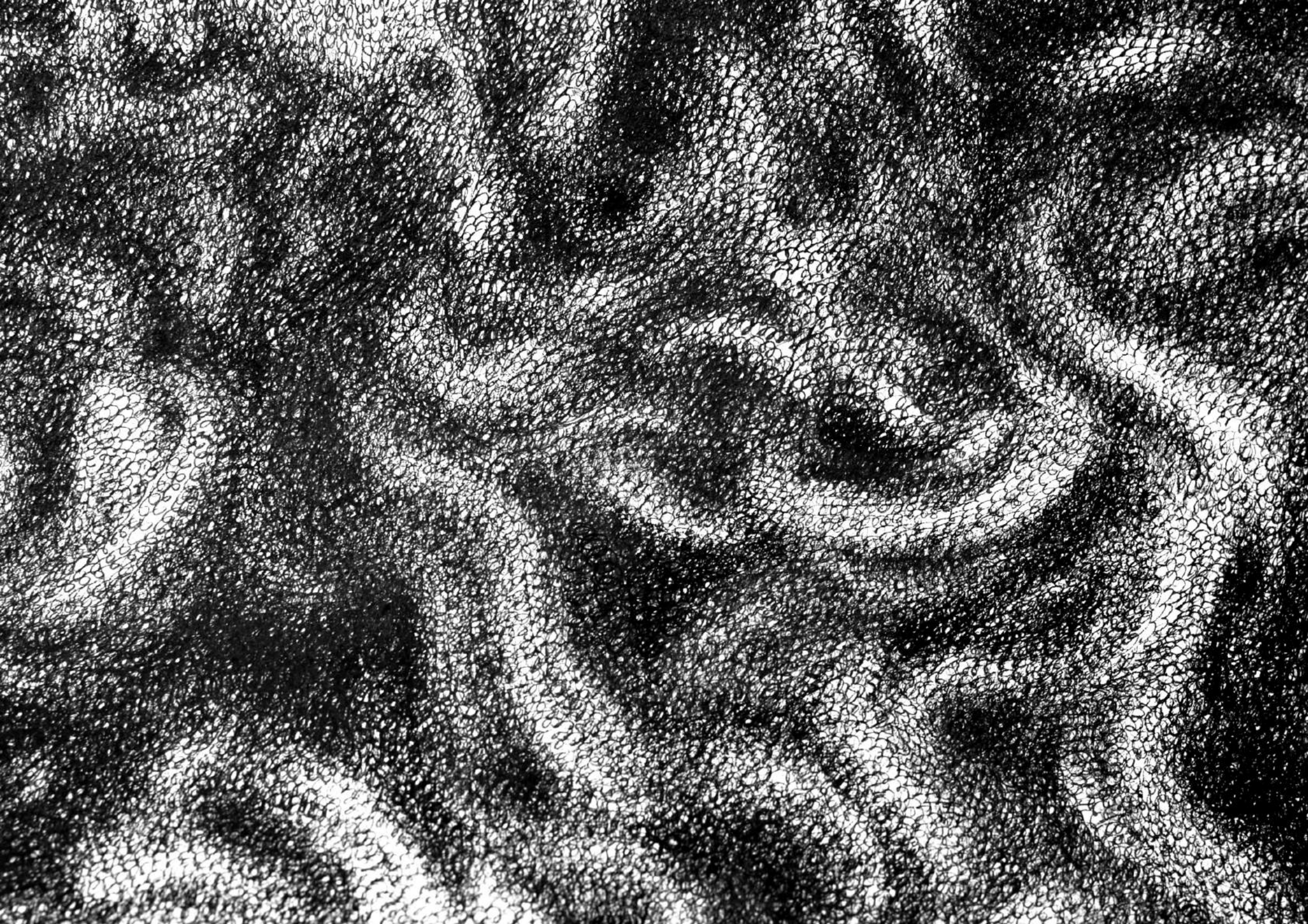
Georg Bohle ziet de gebouwde omgeving en ongerepte landschappen als culturele metaforen die een context bieden voor zijn werk. Sommige van Bohle's tekeningen tonen grafische interpretaties van texturen en compositorische structuren in door de mens gemaakte agglomeraties. Andere werken tonen berglandschappen met antropomorfe rotsformaties.

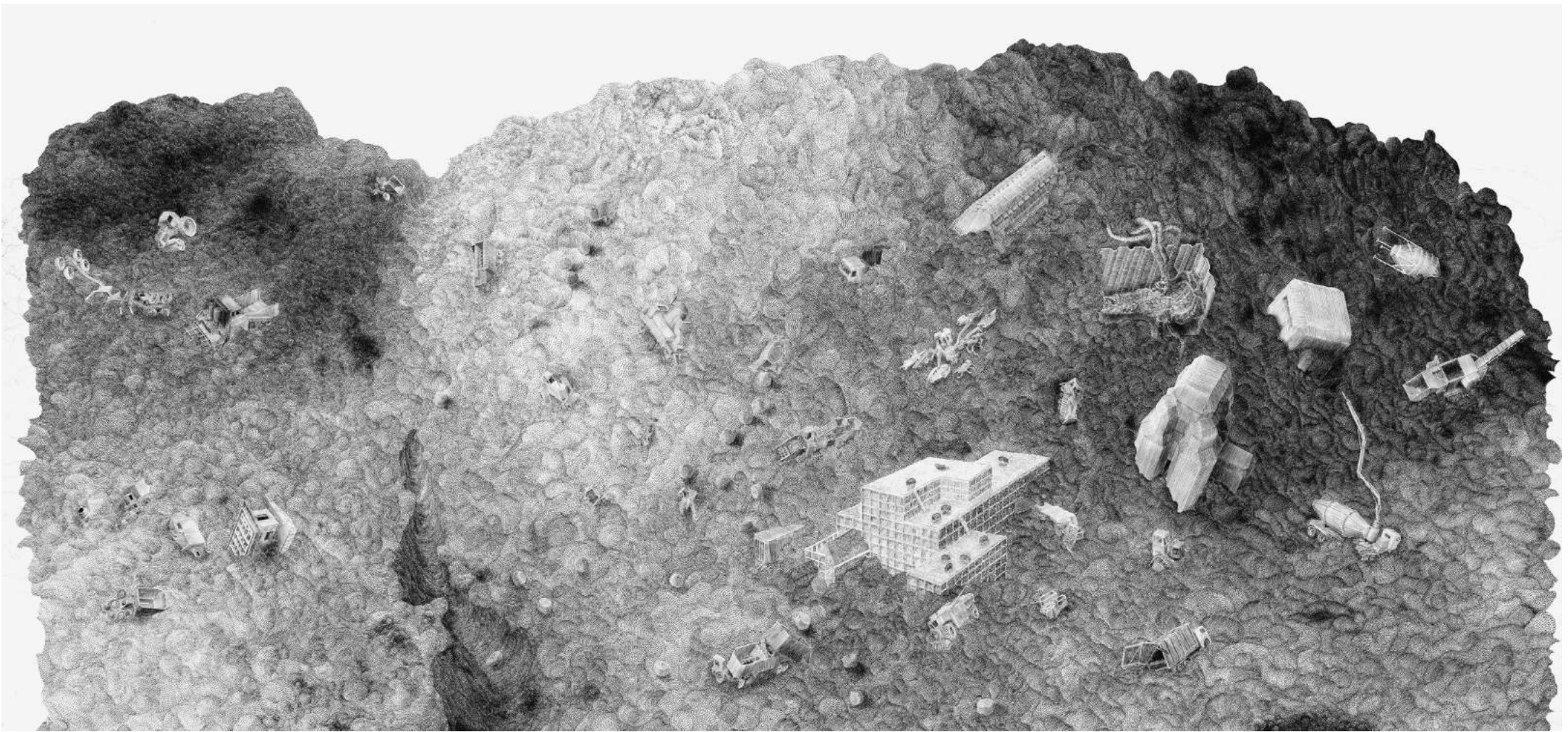
Binnen het spanningsveld van architectonische en natuurlijke vormen, tussen werkelijkheid en het buitenwereldse, ontwikkelt Bohle een groeiende reeks van imaginaire landschappen. De dubbelzinnigheid van curiositeit en herkenbaarheid in Bohle's tekeningen doet denken aan het begrip 'heterotopie' dat Michel Foucault uitwerkte in zijn essay 'Of other spaces' (1967). Men kan dit begrip ontleen om Bohle's tekeningen te aanschouwen want ze lijken te bestaan in een ruimte die noch hier is, noch daar.



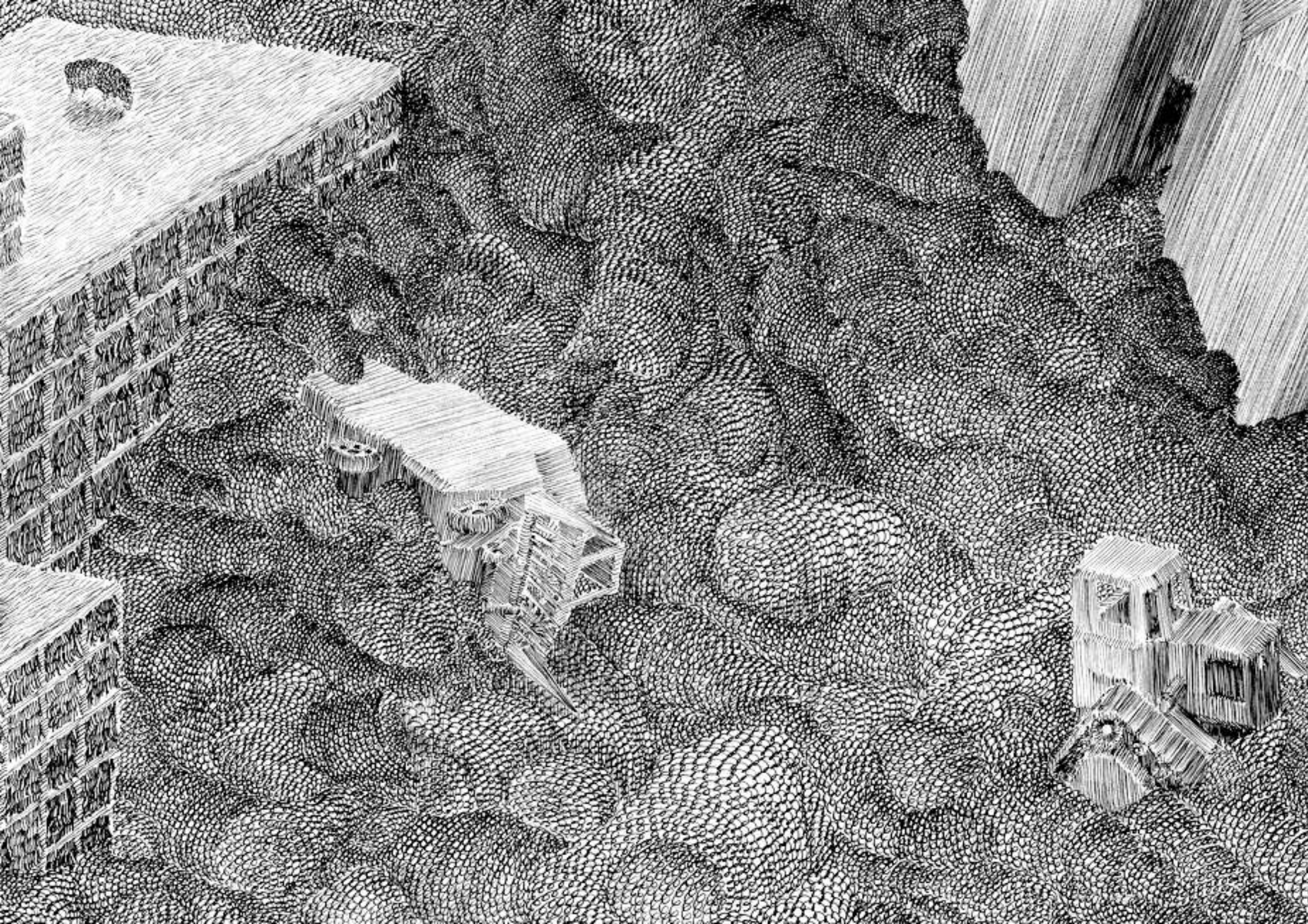


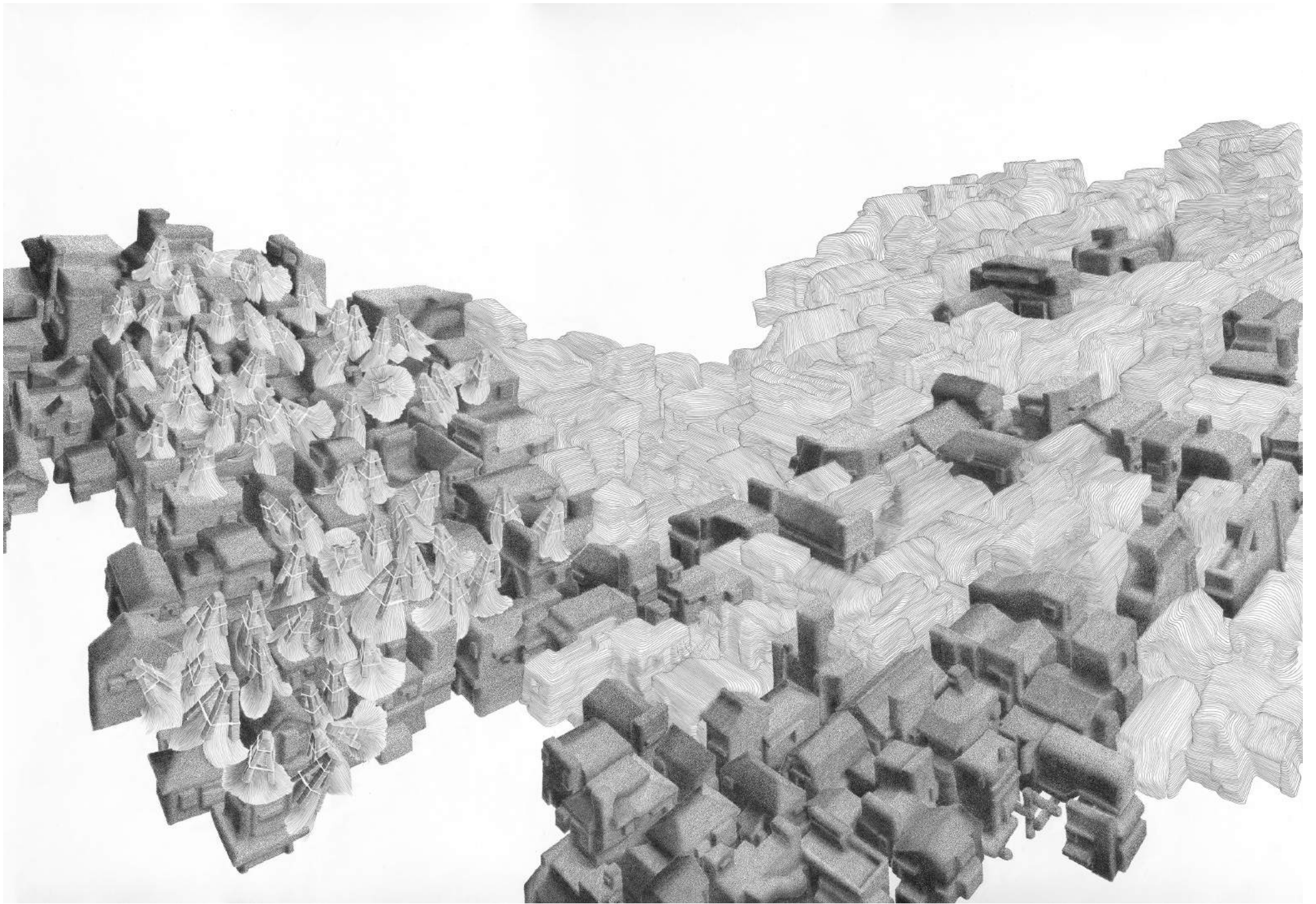
City 3, 2008, Black fineliner on paper, 80 x 105 cm, € 3500,-



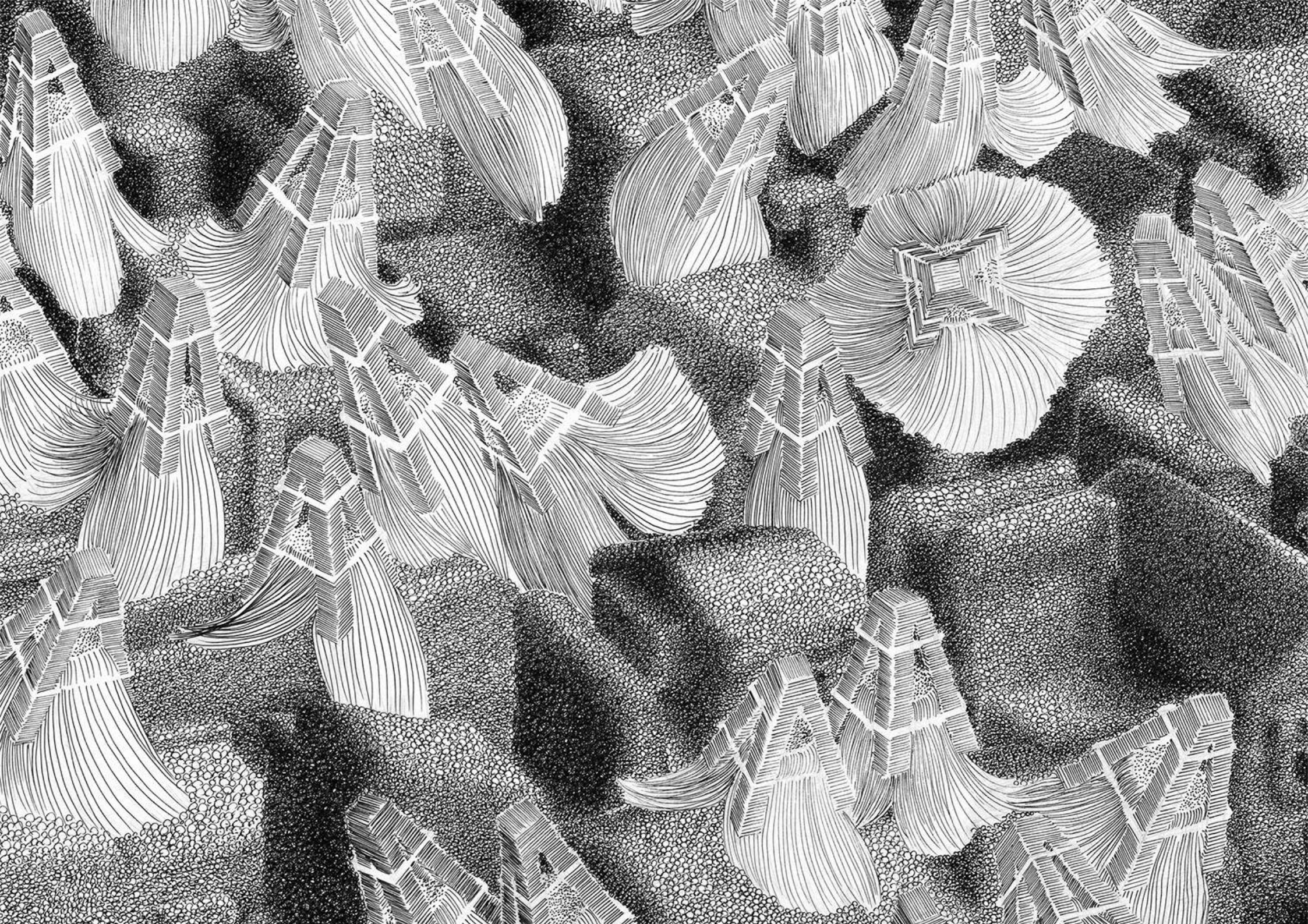


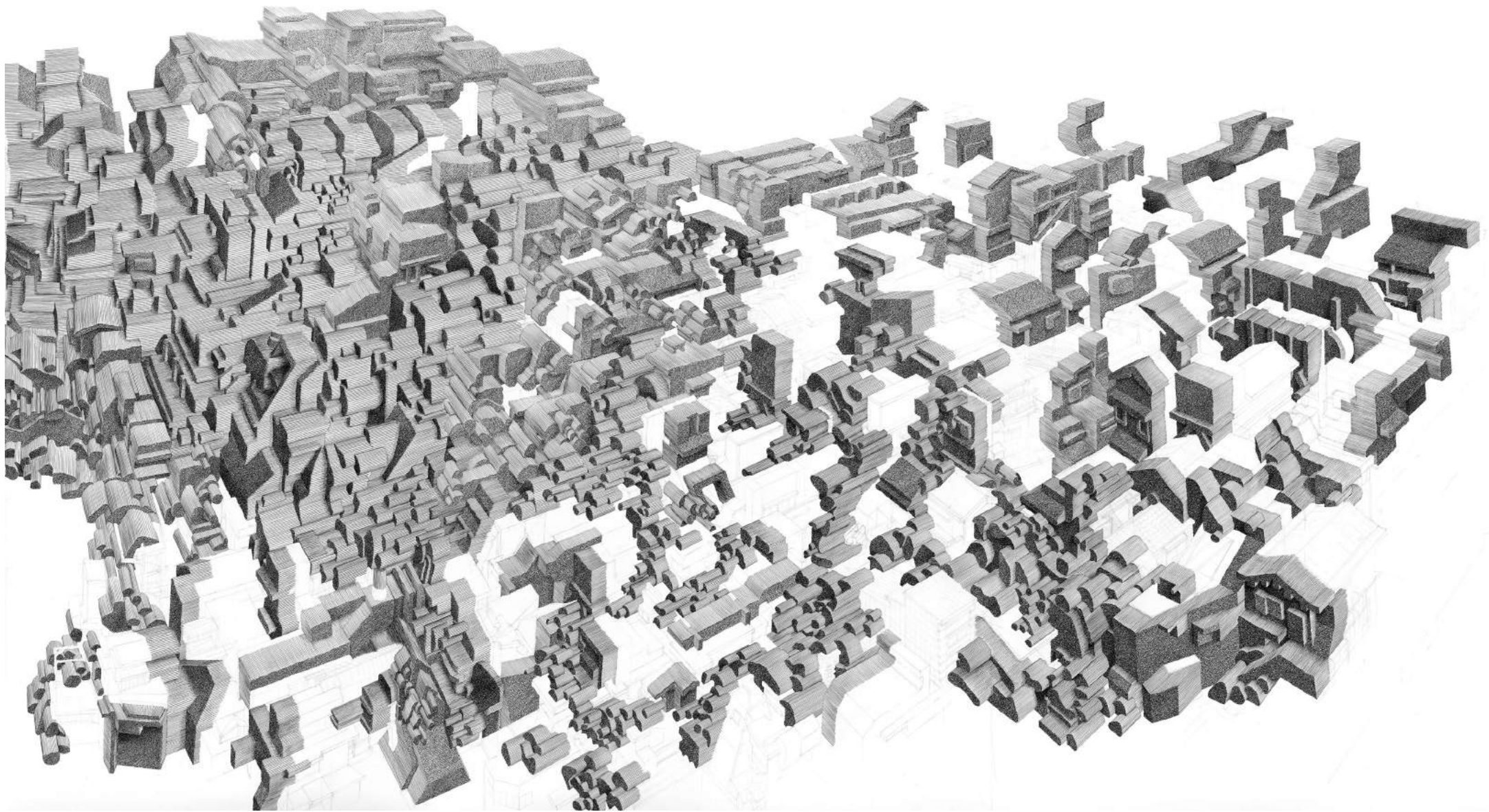
City 6, 2011, Black fineliner on paper, 80 x 105 cm, € 8500,-



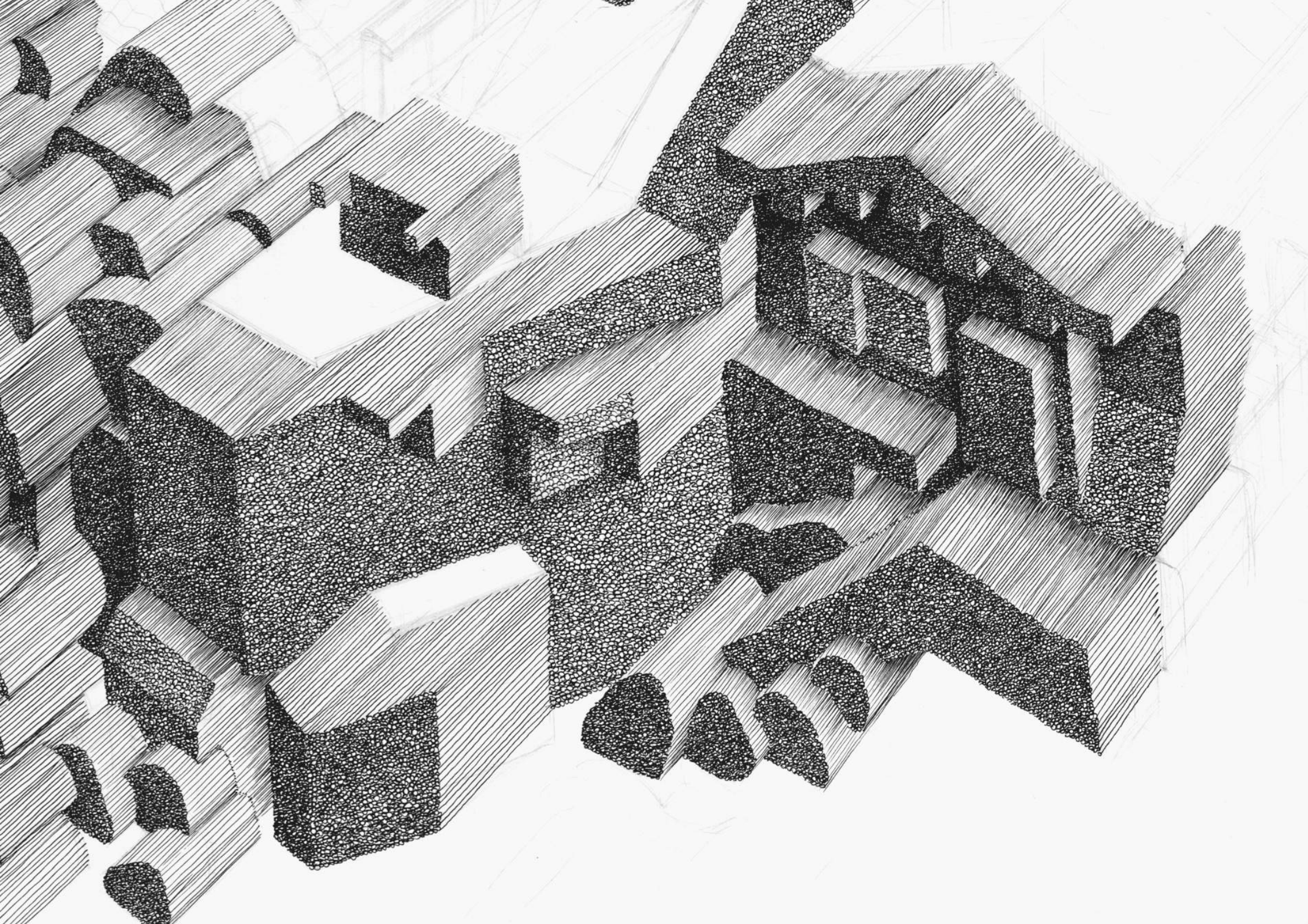


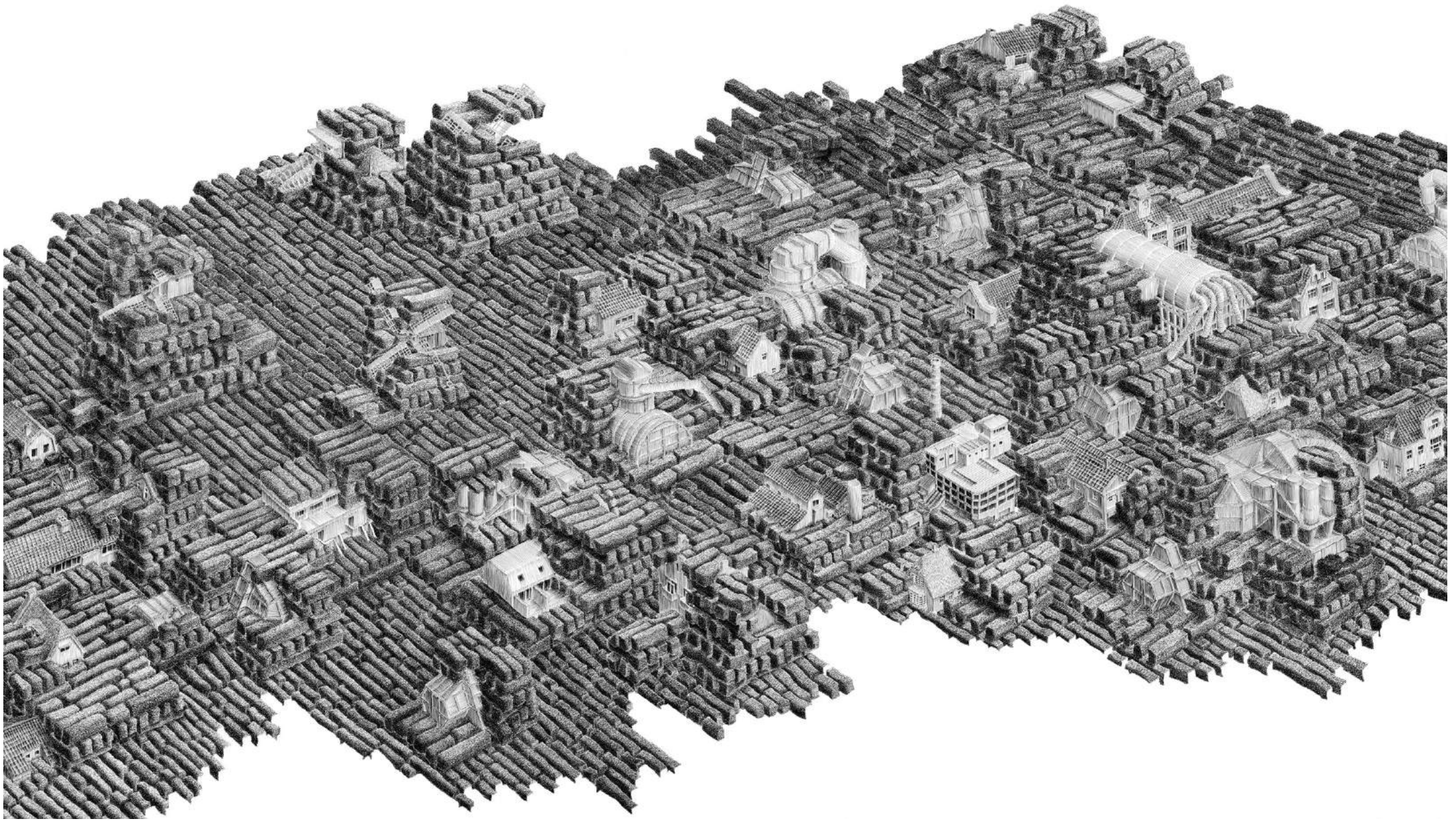
City 11, 2012, Black fineliner on paper, 170 x 115 cm, € 7000,-



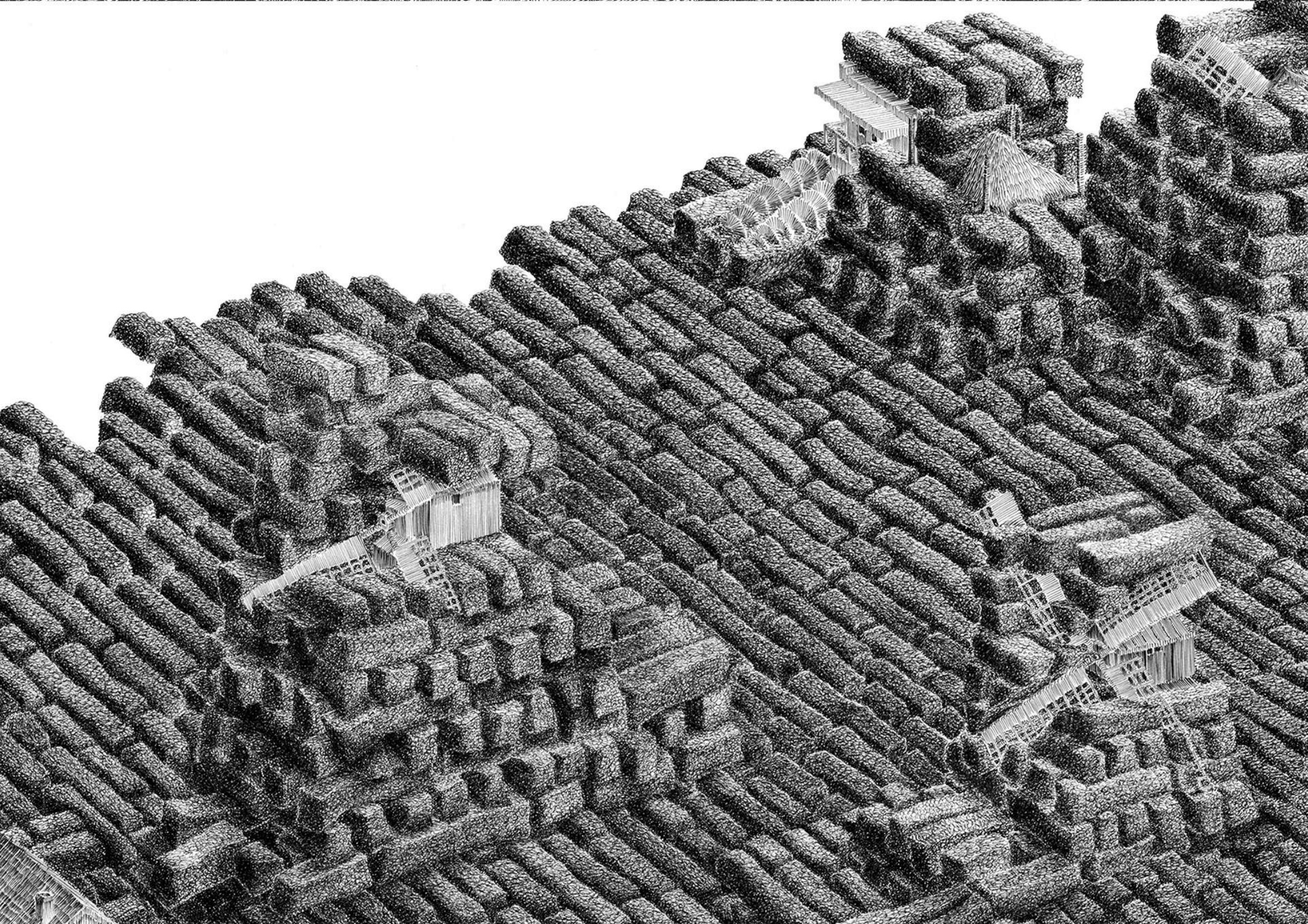


City 12, 2012, Black fineliner on paper, 180 x 108 cm, € 7000,-



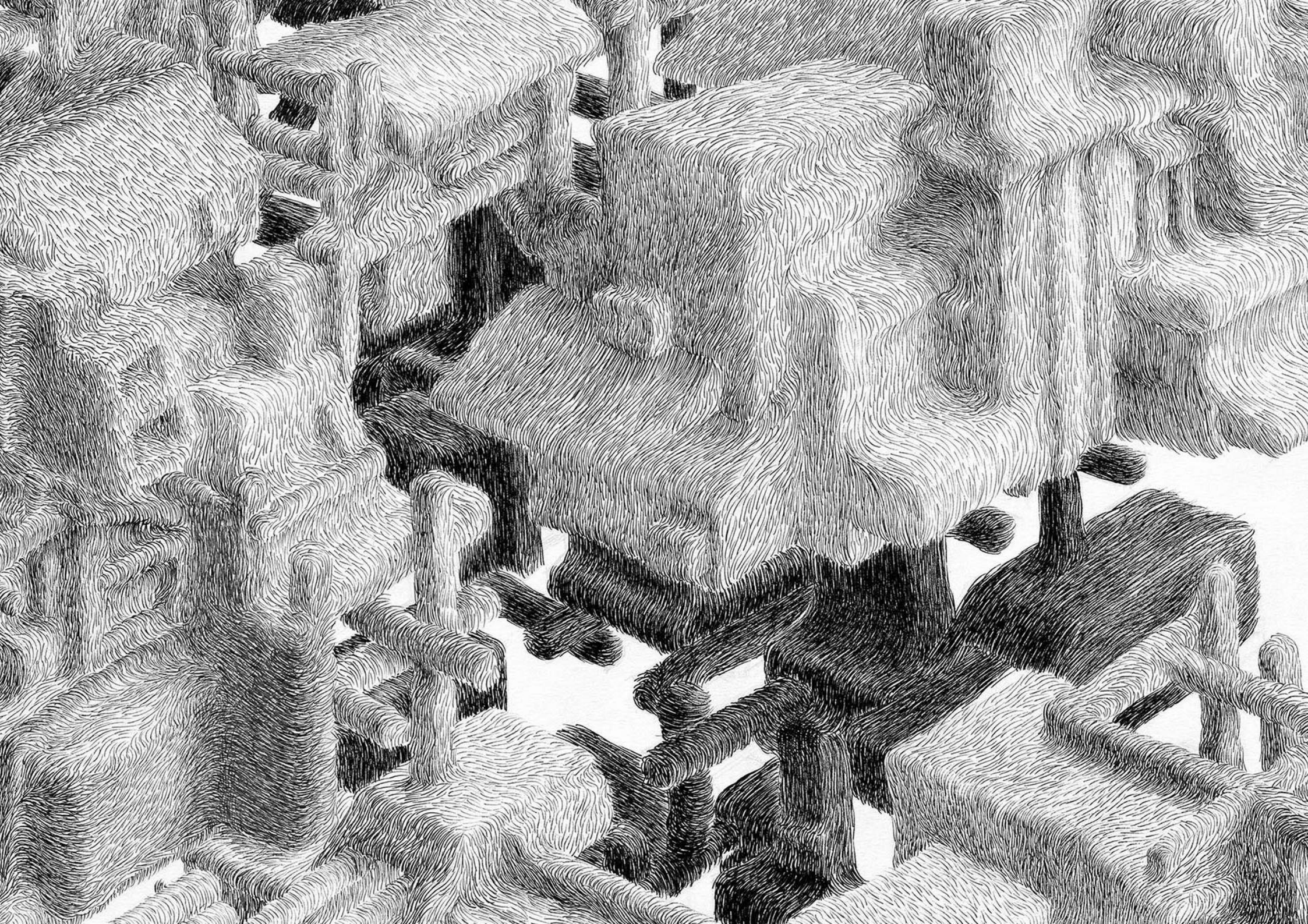


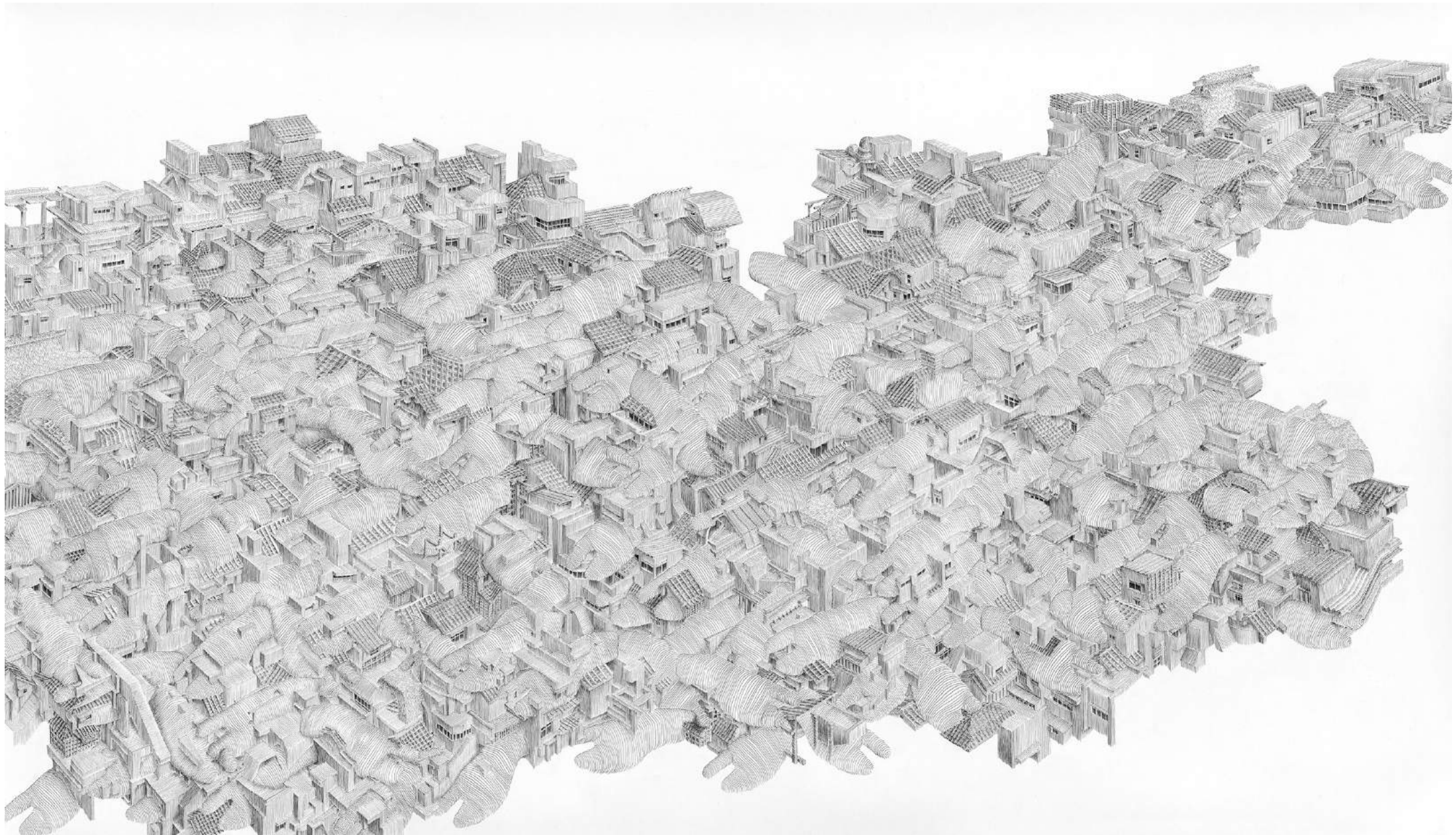
City 15, 2013, Black fineliner on paper, 172 x 110 cm, € 7000,-



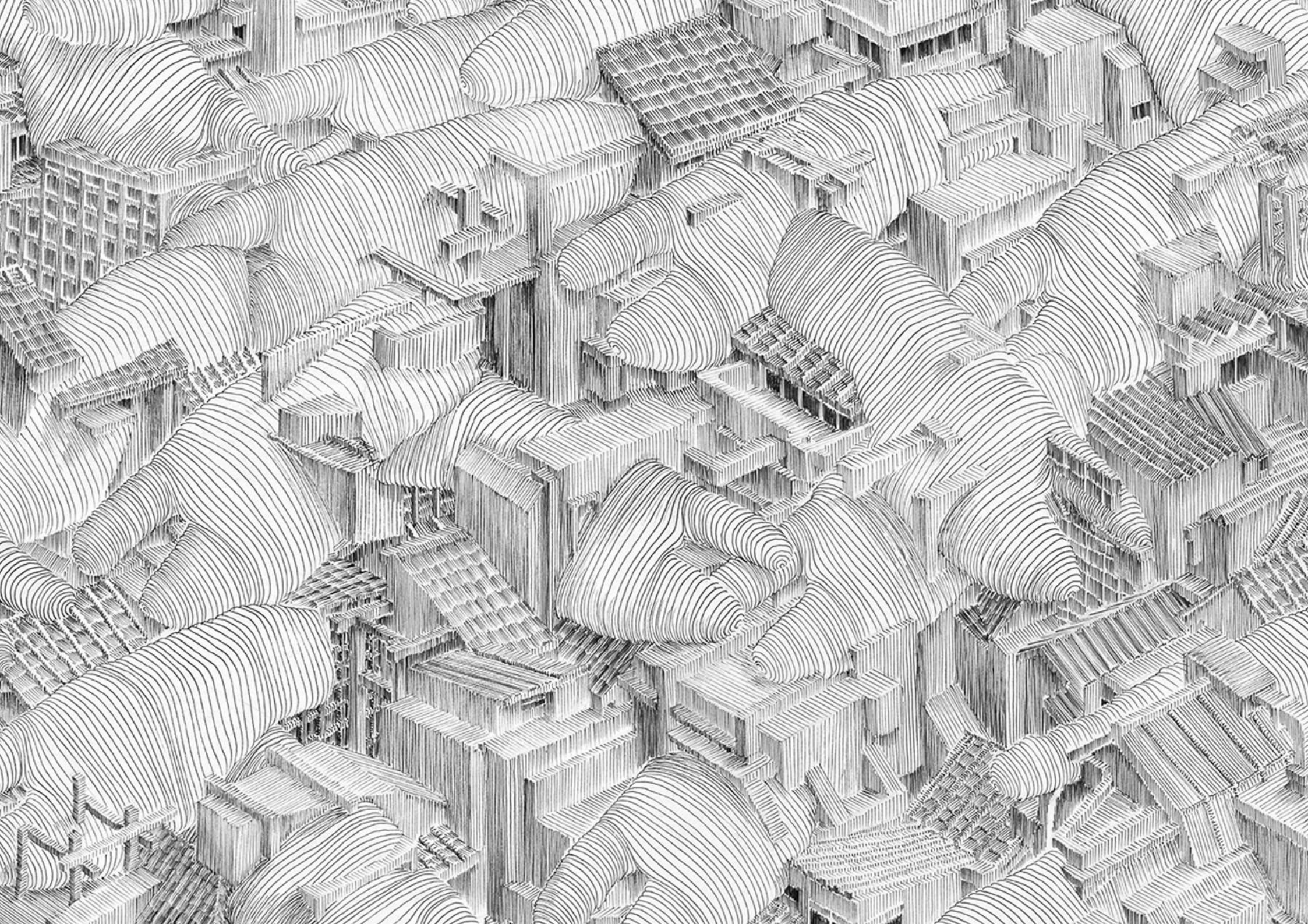


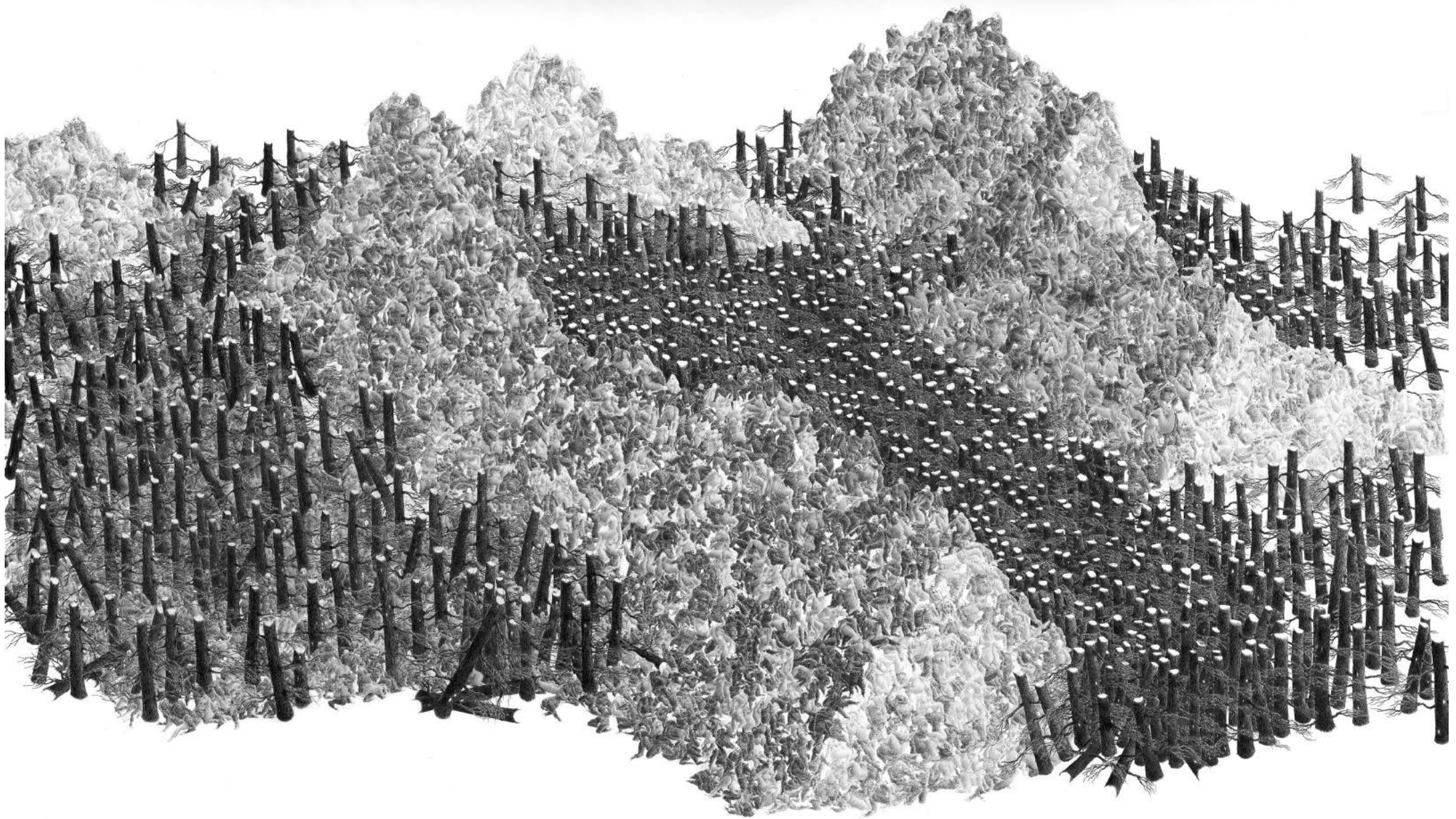
City 17, 2013, Black fineliner on paper, 97 x 210 cm, € 7500,-





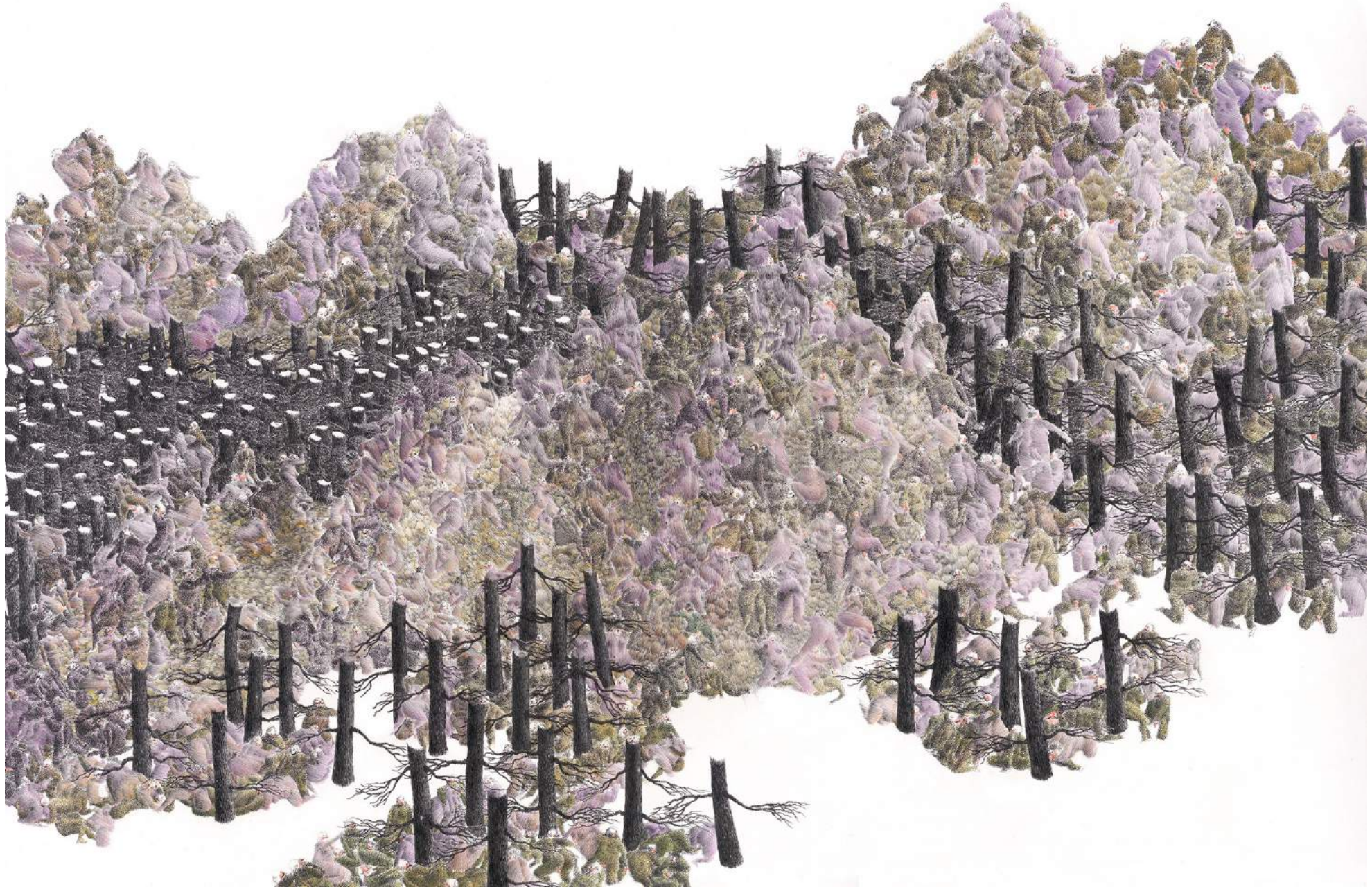

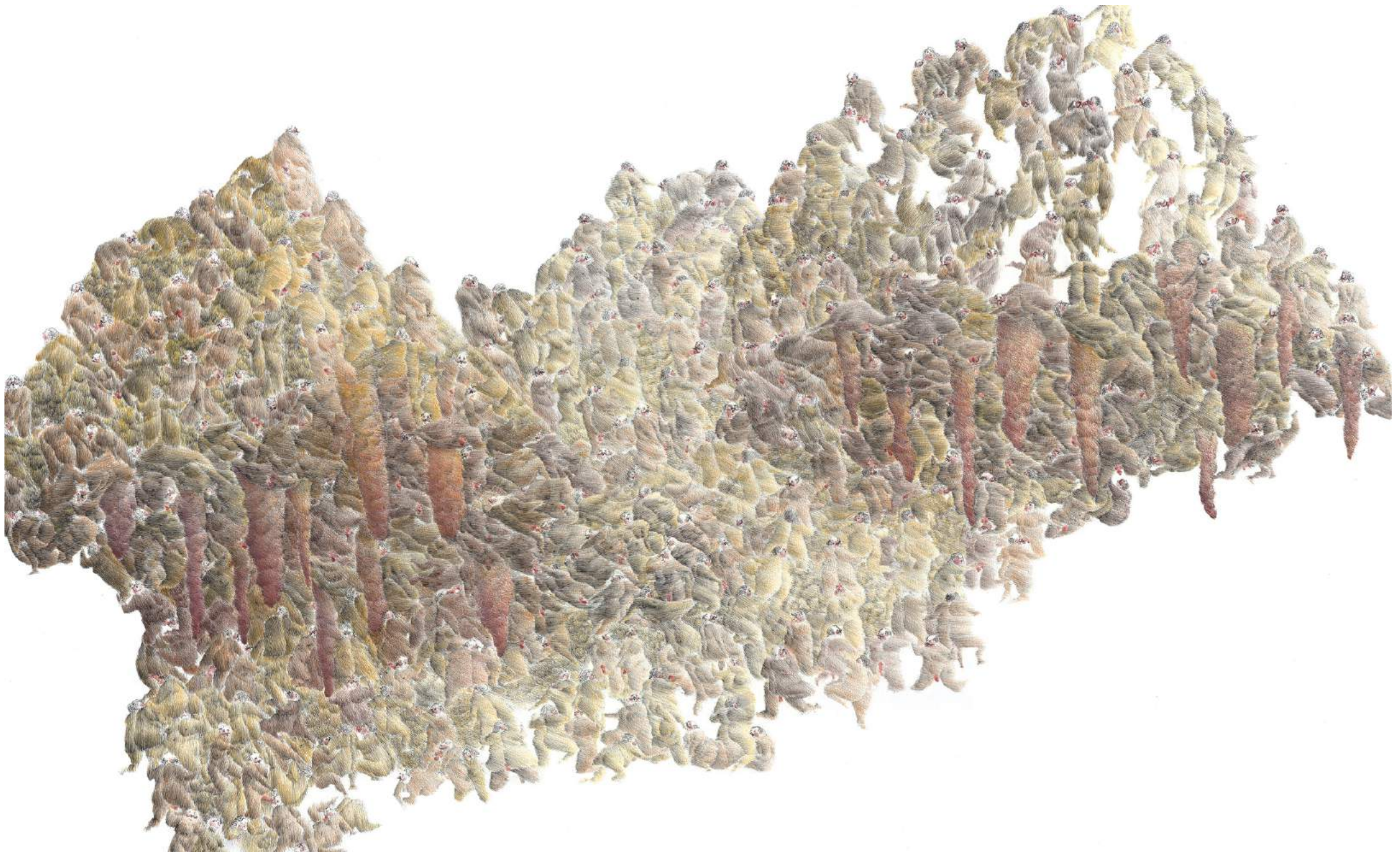
Landscape 22, 2015, Black fineliner, colored pencil on paper, 80 x 109 cm, €6500,-



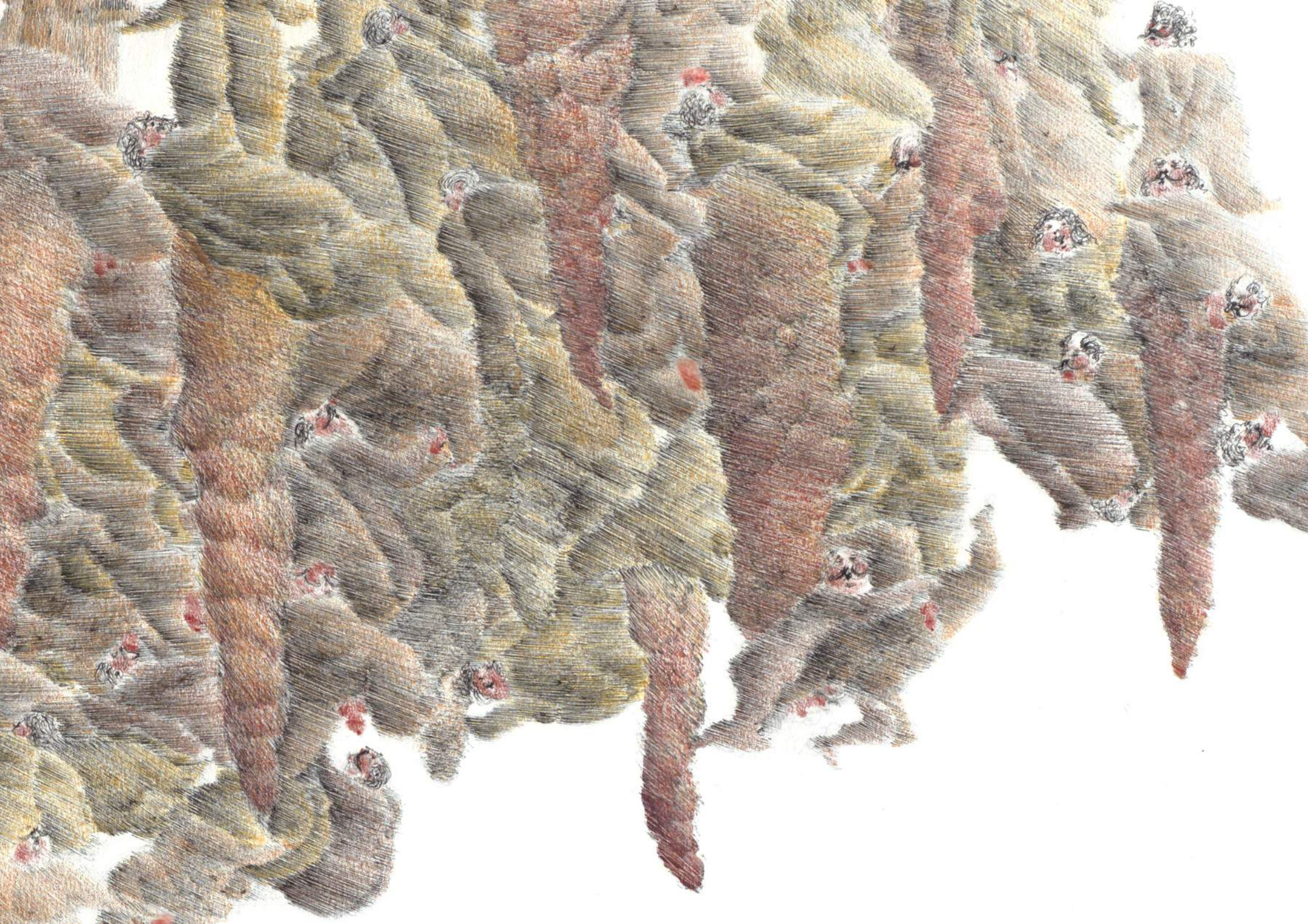


Landscape 23, 2016, Black fineliner, colored pencil on paper,
142 x 108 cm, € 9500,-





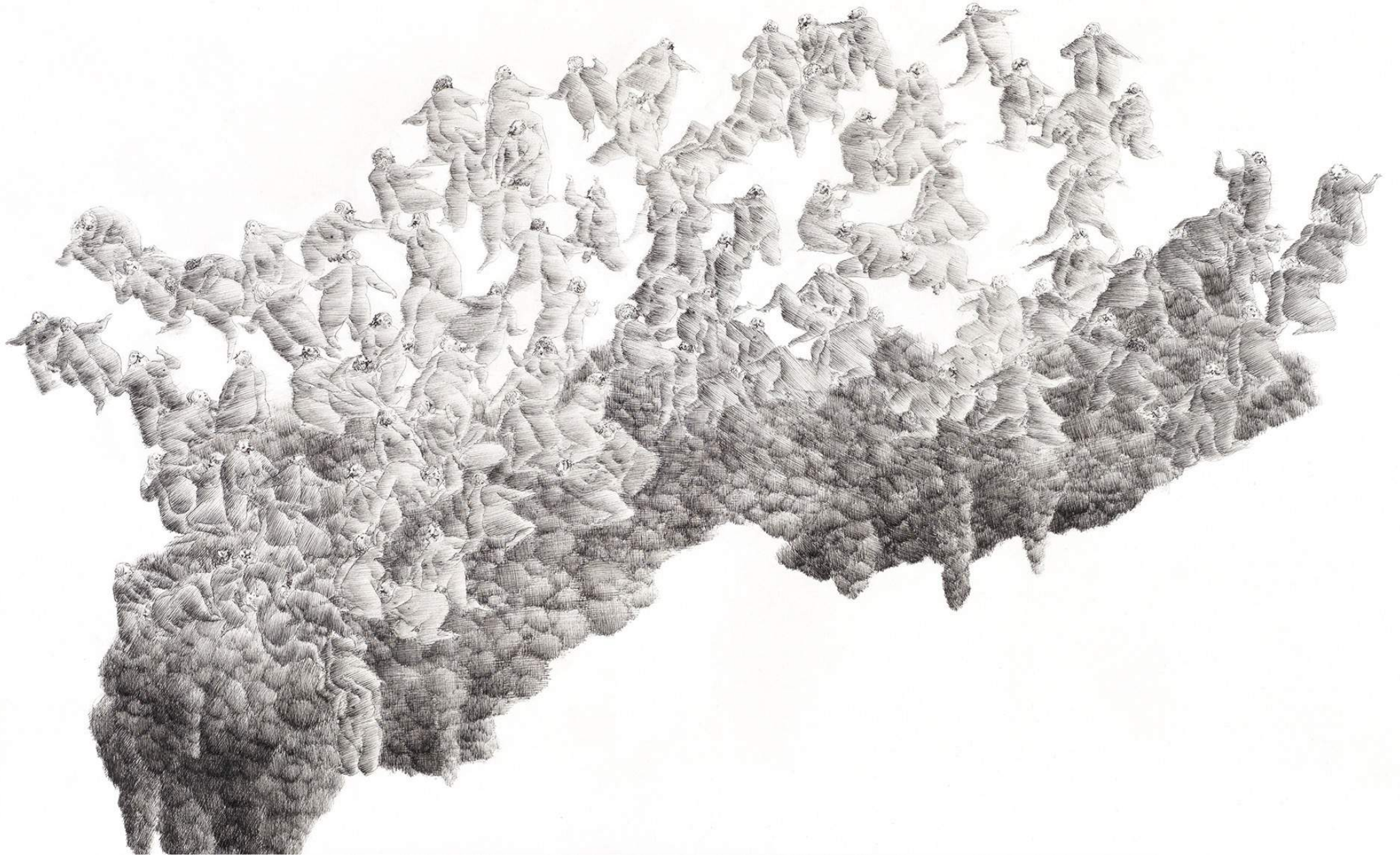
Landscape 24, 2016, Black fineliner, colored pencil on paper, 118 x 78 cm, €4500,-



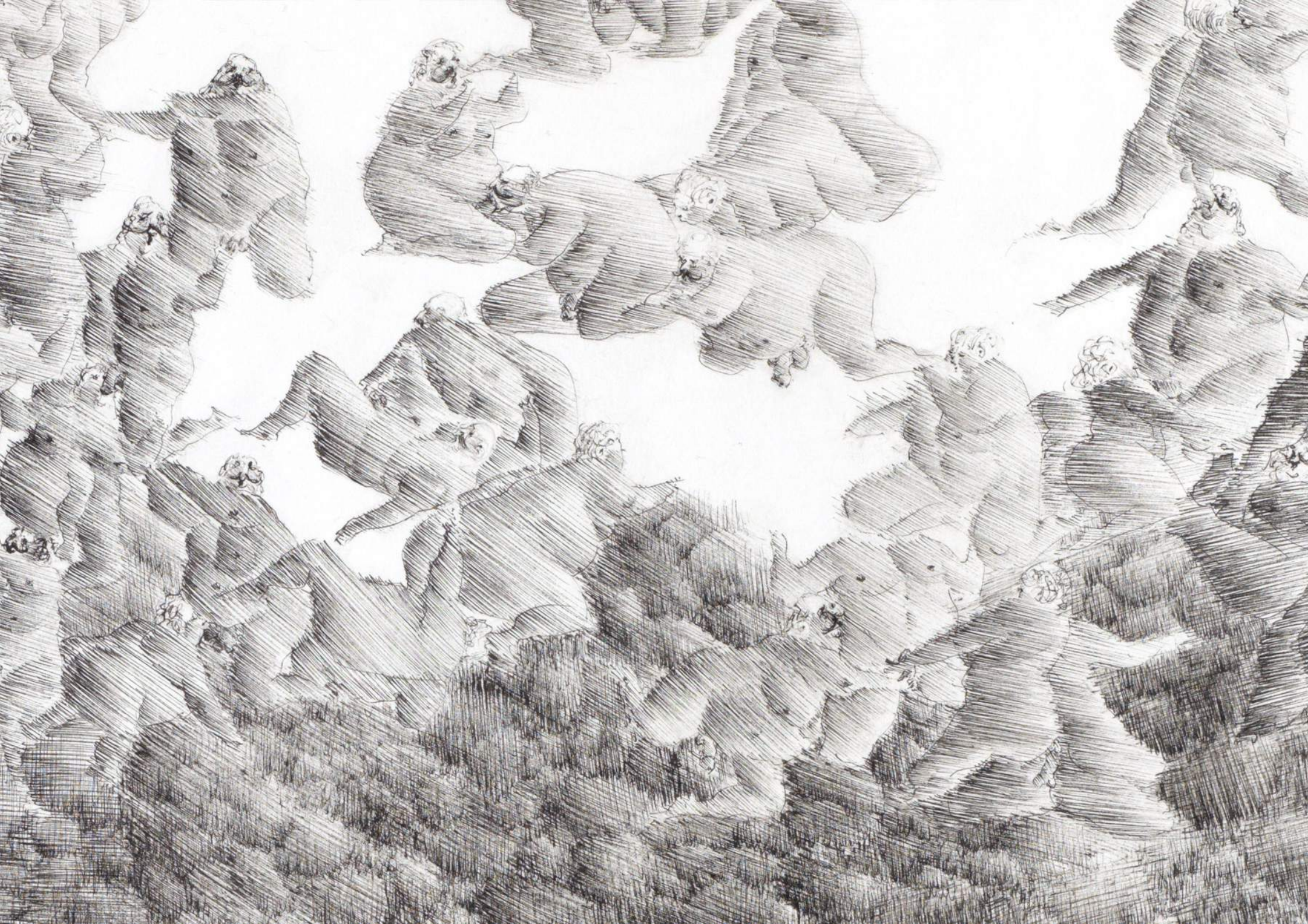


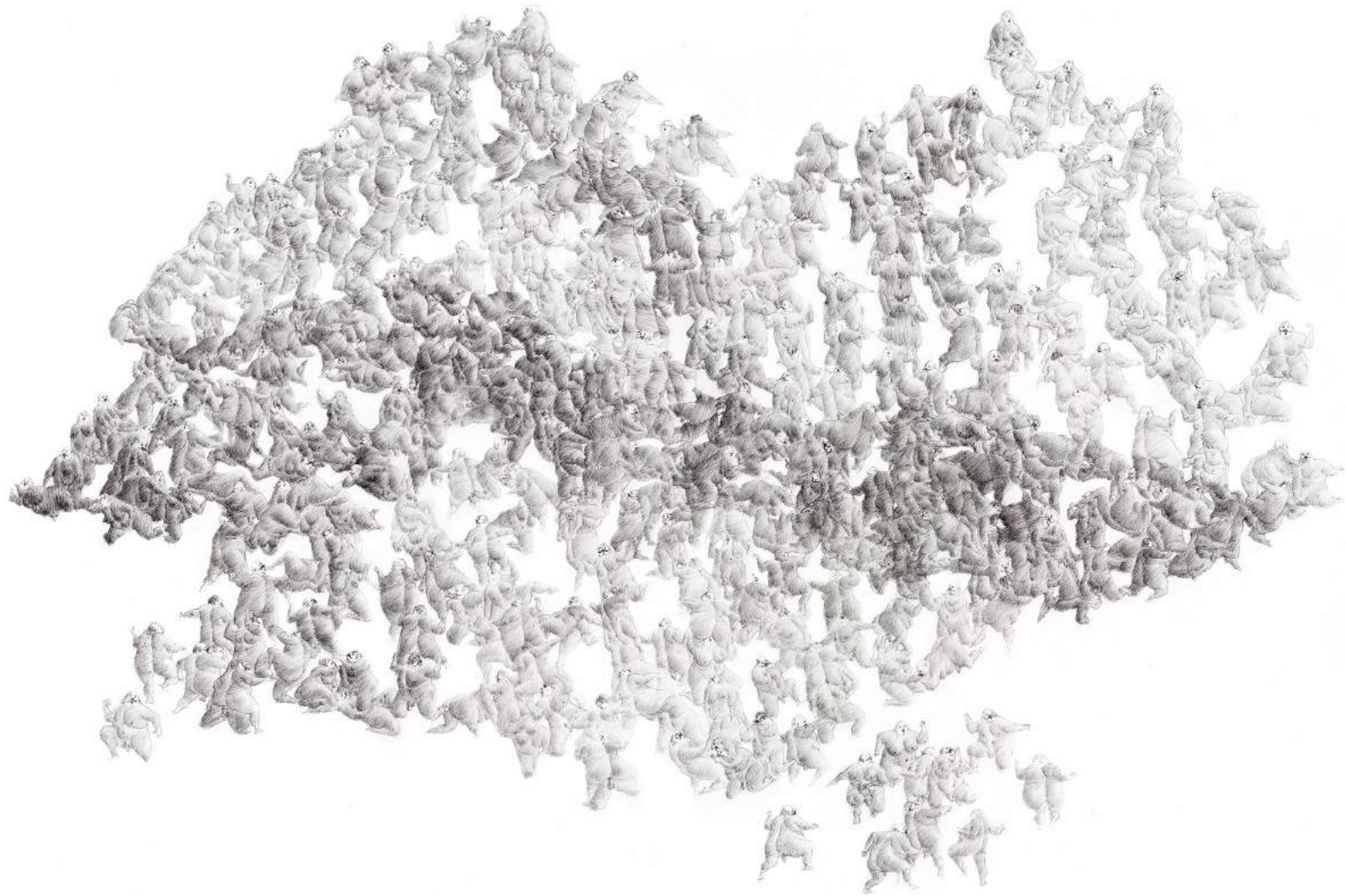
Landscape 25, 2017, 40 x 54 cm, Black fineliner and colored pencil on paper, €2000,-
